

Aquarium Gravel CleanerInstructions

Keeping your aquarium clean is simple with the H2o Pro Gravel Cleaner. Follow these steps for the best results.

Before You Begin, have these essentials ready:

- Bucket
- Towel (for spills)
- H2O PRO Water Conditioner for the fresh water you'll use to refill your tank



Step 1: Position the Cleaner

Hold the gravel cleaner about 10 cm above the gravel surface. Lower the clear tube into your bucket.



Step 2: Start the Siphon

Lower the hose into the bucket.

Pump the gravel cleaner up and down quickly 5–6 times until the water begins to flow.

Caution: You can stop the siphon at any time by placing your thumb over the end of the hose inside the bucket.



Step 3: Clean the Gravel

Gently insert the cleaner into the gravel to lift out trapped debris and waste. Move around the tank to clean each section of gravel.



Step 4: Algae Removal

Use the plastic blade on the end of the intake tube to remove algae from the aquarium glass.



Step 5: Complete the Cleaning

Remove 25–30% of the aquarium water.

Refill the tank with fresh water, treated with H2o Pro Water Conditioner.

Maintenance Advice

Only remove 25–30% of the water during each cleaning. Clean your aquarium every four weeks for a healthy, crystal-clear tank.
